AMPLIFY employees raise over \$10,000 for Children's Miracle Network

Employees of AMPLIFY, an Austin-based credit union, raised \$11,374 for the Children's Miracle Network during the month of May. Gerald Brawley, who works at AMPLIFY's La Frontera location in Round Rock, was the top fundraiser among all Austin credit unions, raising over \$4,000.

The fundraiser is an annual event. All Austin-based credit unions participate in selling raffle tickets to benefit Children's Miracle Network as part of the "Credit Unions for Kids" campaign, a national charitable effort to benefit 170 CMN-affiliated hospitals which serve 17 million kids. In Austin, funds raised are donated to the Dell Children's Medical Center.

Brawley says it's not difficult to sell raffle tickets for such a good cause, but admits he got a little extra motivation from his wife. Former AMPLIFY employee Gloria Riverkamp previously held the record for the most tickets sold with 1,900. She retired earlier this year and married Gerald in April. Gerald says, "I knew if I didn't sell at least twice as many tickets as Gloria, I wouldn't get any credit at all. So I set a goal for myself to sell 3800 tickets."
